Tomorrow is the anniversary of my ordination. Twenty seven years ago since I was officially 'revved up!' It has been a long journey to get there - or so it seemed at the time. It was then still relatively unusual for a woman to become a Baptist Minister. Although we got there rather sooner than the Anglicans in 1994. In fact it is 100 years this week since Violet Hedger was ordained to the Baptist Ministry, on 3rd February 1926. The Baptist Union has named a major initiative in her honour "Project Violet" which seeks to overcome the remaining obstacles to women in ministry: the so-called 'Stained Glass Ceiling'.

Yesterday Dame Sarah Mullaly was recognised as the first woman Archbishop of Canterbury. Times certainly change. We congratulate and pray for her and our siblings in the Church of England. The theme I chose for my ordination service was the faithfulness of God. That is one thing that does not change. He never gives up on us or abandons us. That is still my testimony. He is the God who continues to call men and women to serve him and follow him.
